Did you know that we have a self monitoring blood pressure machine at Fressingfield?- Patients can now "drop in" at a time convenient to them at Fressingfield and take their own blood pressure without having to make an appointment. If you suffer from high blood pressure it is recommended you have your blood pressure taken every 6mths. If you do not have high blood pressure but are over 40 years it is recommended you have a blood pressure check every 5yrs.

Funding crisis - GP Practices need your support - less money means a cut in services for patients

Despite carrying out 90% of all NHS contacts, general practice only receives 8.39% of the NHS budget in the UK. By 2017, with the proposed cuts to our existing budgets this is projected to plunge to just 7.29%.

From April of this year and every year for the next 7 years our practice will receive a cut in our overall funding for services.

General practice is facing a growing crisis; a recent survey of nearly 500 GPs shows that they expect average waiting times for a doctors appointment to increase from nine days in April 2014 to 13 days from April 2015. GP leaders said that this is indicative of increasing workloads and reductions in resources.

The Royal College of General Practitioners and the British Medical Association want to petition the Prime Minister to increase the share of the NHS budget spent on general practice.

THE NHS SHINGLES VACCINATION PROGRAMME

The shingles vaccination this year will be offered to people aged **70 years, 78 years** & **79 years**. The efficacy of the vaccine declines with age and so it is not recommended for people aged 80 years and older. **The catch-up Programme** - is a phased programme and we will know more in the coming years with regards to when the programme will be introduced to those people currently aged between 71 and 77.

Who is Eligible for the shingles vaccine? – From September of this year the NHS have confirmed that it will only be available to those people that were born between

2nd September 1943 & 1st September 1944 (Aged 70)

2nd September 1935 & 1st September 1936 (Aged 78)

2nd September 1934 & 1st September 1935 (Aged 79)

We will write to all eligible patients in August asking them to book an appointment in our September clinics, the NHS have confirmed that we are not able to provide the vaccination to eligible patients until September.
